£9.50 for 16 to 20 colonies, £11.10 for 21 to 25 colonies, £13.60 for 26 to 30 colonies,

SGBKA Membership Secretary

Method of Payment

2. For BACS payments please transfer the membership fees to "SGBKA" Bank HSBC: Sort Code 40-44-41: Account Number 21426664. In the Reference section please enter your surname and initials followed by "Subs".
3. For payment by cheque or cash please post a copy of the completed form together with payment to the membership secretary. Please make cheques payable to "SGBKA".
4. Alternatively please give the form and payment to Kirsty or the Treasurer, Jerry Harding, at a SGBKA meeting.

Membership Category

5. Failure to renew membership before 1 December causes significant and time-consuming work for a number of unpaid individuals and hence there is an additional charge for late renewal.
6. Membership has to be in one name only. Partners/family members are welcome at all branch meetings. However if a partner /family member wishes to access benefits available to BBKA members, i.e. insurance for 3 hives, third party insurance up to £10M, discounted ticket to the BBKA Spring Convention and participation at BBKA events, they have to join as a partner member.
7. Social Membership is appropriate if you do not anticipate owning bees during the membership year. Social members can transfer to full membership at any time by paying an additional £21.50. Social members can attend all SGBKA events and will receive all SGBKA correspondence but will not receive the BBKA News.

Bee Disease Insurance

8. Bee Diseases Insurance Limited (BDI) is a registered community benefit society that offers insurance against loss of beekeeping equipment to beekeepers in England and Wales, who have had their bees destroyed or treated by the Bee Inspector as a result of being infected by a notifiable disease. Full details of the BDI Insurance cover can be found on the BDI website: <http://www.beediseasesinsurance.co.uk/home>.
9. For members renewing on time BDI insurance starts from the date payment is received by the SGBKA. For members paying after 31 March, including new members and late renewals insurance starts 40 days after payment is received by the SGBKA. For members increasing the number of colonies part way through the year the additional insurance starts 40 days after additional payment is received by the SGBKA.

11. Partner Membership does not include bee disease insurance, which has to be through the Registered Member for all jointly managed colonies.
12. Junior membership does not include bee disease insurance, which is normally through a registered adult member (e.g. parent or grandparent). If there is no adult member and insurance is required please contact the Membership Secretary.

Data Protection

13. The SGBKA holds your personal data so that we can contact you to provide information on branch events, meetings and local beekeeping news. The GBKA holds your name and address for publication in the GBKA year book. The BBKA holds your name and address to provide you with BBKA News, leaflets and information from the National Bee Unit. **Your membership cannot be processed unless you acknowledge that SGBKA, GBKA and BBKA hold your personal data.**
14. BDI holds your personal data in providing insurance for beekeeping equipment. For clarification of a claim, or for establishing the disease history of a beekeeper, may pass data to the National Bee Unit. For details of BDI Data Protection Policy see the BDI information page <http://www.beediseasesinsurance.co.uk/about-1>. **You cannot have bee disease insurance unless you agree to BDI holding your personal data.**
15. The National Bee Unit (NBU) holds your data in order to provide its services to beekeepers. For details of the NBU's Personal information charter see <https://www.gov.uk/government/organisations/animal-and-plant-health-agency/about/personal-information-charter>. **If you do not agree to the NBU holding your personal data you will not get the NBU services.**

Gift Aid

16. To qualify for Gift Aid you must pay an amount in Income Tax or Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the amount GBKA will claim each tax year. Currently they claim an extra 25p for every £1 of your subscription, at no extra cost to you. Please advise us if in the future you change your name or address or no longer qualify for Gift Aid. The GBKA is Registered Charity Number 263712.
